

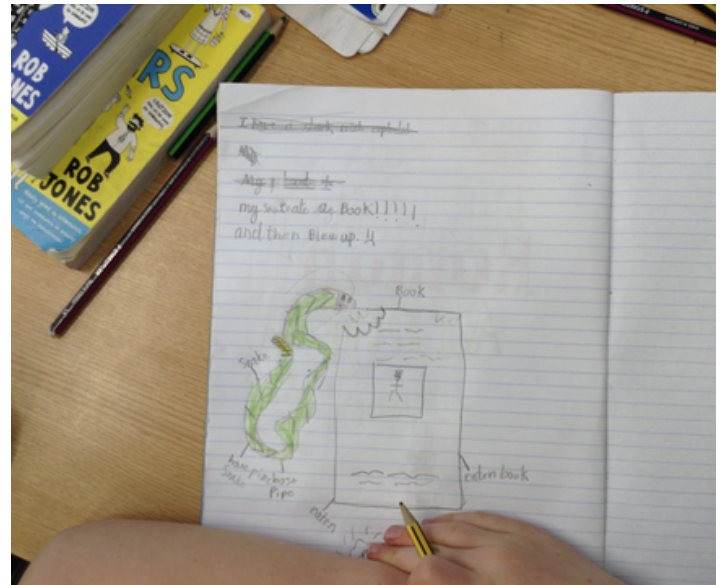

Car Parking



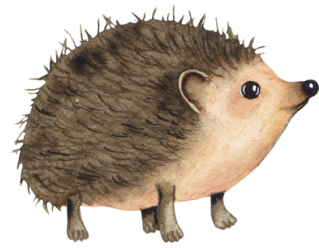
When parking on the mound area, please can we ask that parents park as far forward as possible so that the entrance onto the mound is not blocked. Thank you.
