We are very excited to be welcoming Art Solutions to Wortham Primary next Monday and Tuesday. They will be working with staff, children and parents on a collaborative art project which will be displayed in our front foyer. We are looking forward to sharing this experience with you and cannot wait to see the final product on display!

History Workshops

To enrich our history curriculum, the staff have been organising workshops for the children to experience. We are very excited to be inviting 'One Day Creative' to deliver a Black History performing arts based workshop to year six. 'Portals to the Past' will be coming in and presenting a 'Stone Age – Iron Age' workshop for Hedgehog class and finally Barn Owl class will be engaging with a variety of virtual Mayan workshops throughout their topic and will get to take part in a live question and answer session with a Dr. Diane, an archaeologist who specialise in the Mayans!

Suffolk Wildlife Trust

At the end of last term, we began working with Suffolk Wildlife Trust and volunteers from Redgrave and Lopham Fen. For the next two years rest of the year, they will be working with the school and particularly with the children in year 4, on a project to help improve the biodiversity of our school grounds. The children have already begun working on the project and we are looking forward to seeing how the project develops.

Behaviour policy & Star of the Week

We have recently reviewed our behaviour policy and have made some changes which we believe are going to support us in continuing to providing a safe, nurturing and empowering environment for our children to learn and grow. Our new policy has been uploaded to our school website so please do take a moment to read it.

We are keen for children our children to learn how to identify for themselves when they have accomplished something that they are proud of. Whilst we will continue to provide extrinsic methods of rewarding children, such as special messages home and stickers, we will be replacing 'Star of the Week' by inviting every child to recognise themselves something they are proud of. The children will then record this on their own certificate which they will bring home to share and celebrate with you. We are looking forward to hearing and seeing the children sharing how amazing they are!
