Curriculum and Learning

The children have settled back into school beautifully since having their Easter break. They are now fully immersed into their topics which include: The Great Fire of London (Bumblebee Class), Worham Bakery (Hedgehog Class), Designing and making a picture frame (Barn Owl Class) and Designing and making storage solutions (Otter Class).

Interim Reports

As you will already be aware, your child's annual school report will now be completed and sent to you at the end of the summer term, instead of the Easter term as we had planned. Although teachers have communicated regularly with parents during the Spring term and lockdown period, we feel that it is important to inform you on how well your child has been doing since they returned back to school.

We would not usually send an interim report at this point of the year, but we felt it was important to formally report to you on your child's current attainment and progress and to also make you aware of any support that they may need between now and the end of the year.

The interim reports will be in their usual format but with some extra elements: in addition to providing your child's teacher assessed attainment levels (working towards, expected or greater depth), we will also include the standardised score that your child has achieved in their termly assessments for reading and maths. Teachers have also written a short comment to provide you with an explanation for these assessment results and detailed any support that your child may need.

Interim reports will be sent home with your child on Friday 7th May. If you have any questions or wish to discuss your child's interim report further, please contact your child's class teacher to arrange a time.

School Events

This is the time of year when we would usually be organising many school events for all our children to enjoy. As I am sure you can understand, due to the current situation, we are unfortunately unable to plan anything until we know that it is safe to do so. We will be awaiting further information from the Government on the 21st June and then we will be able to decide if and how we can run any events, including Sports Day. Therefore, anything that we do plan for our children will most likely be arranged at short notice, but we will of course give you as much notice as possible.
