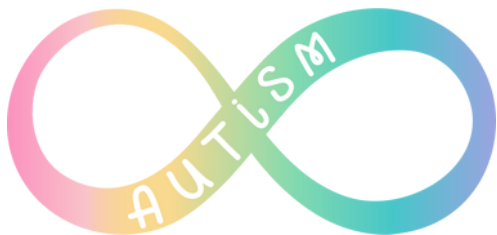
Next week, we are looking forward to celebrating Neurodiversity Celebration Week!
