After school clubs: a letter will be sent out when we return and clubs will begin the week commencing 12th September.

Swimming: During the 1st half of Autumn term, children in year 5 and 6 will be going swimming. In the 2nd half of the Autumn term, children in year 4 and 5 will be going along with any children from year 6 who, at that point, have not met the National Curriculum standard of swimming 25m. A letter with further details will be sent out when we return in September.

School Dinners: due to the cost-of-living increases, we have been notified by our catering supplier that the cost of a paid lunch for years 3-6 will be £2.50 from 1st September.

Uniform: white blouse, shirt or polo-shirt, black/ grey skirt, shorts or trousers, green sweatshirt or cardigan. Green gingham, black or grey dresses.

School shoes: all children should wear sensible shoes in black (not boots, high heels or trainers). All children should have trainers which they use for break times and PE.

PE uniform: black/navy shorts and green polo-shirts. Children with long hair must have their hair tied up. A hair tie kept in their PE kit may be useful. Please can earrings be removed on PE days or tape provided so children can tape over their earrings; this is for their safety.

Please note that children are not allowed to wear jewellery, only stud earrings (not hoops) and please ensure any nail varnish is removed.

Medication: Should your child require medication during the day, this must be given in at the school office and not left in children's bags. Parents must also sign a consent form.

Water bottles: children must have a named water bottle in school that they can bring into the classroom. These need to be bought in each Monday and will be bought home on a Friday. Children who have a packed lunch may like to have a bottle in their packed lunch as well as a bottle for the classroom.

Hedgehog Class: will need a bookbag (not a rucksack) as we keep these in the classroom. They will not need to bring their own pencil case or colouring pens etc as they have these on their tables.

Barn Owls and Otters: Please can children have a **small** bag for their belongings. Children in these classes are welcome to bring their own stationery and pencil cases to be kept in their bag, however, all stationery is provided in class.

First day back for the children: Friday 2nd September
